The Fund

Created in May 2014 under the aegis of the KING BAUDOUIIN FOUNDATION, Brussels

- **Serve the two AIESEC communities:**
 - Reinforce their role on education, training and leadership
 - Finance some of their projects, individual or collective
- **Missions:**
 - Tutoring activities, mentorship and training, international job exchanges
 - Seminars, publications, special events..
 - AI & AAI development: traineeship “leads” to AIESEC, database, websites, professional services among/with alumni,
- **Values: those of AIESEC since its creation**
 - International understanding and cultural sharing
 - Concern with the social character of economics and business
 - Concern with permanent education adapted towards development and sustainability
 - Concern with diversity, equality and respect for others,
 - Concern with international exchanges in a globalized world,
 - Responsibility and humanism, transparency, innovation and excellence
- **Donations are managed by the KING BAUDOUIIN Foundation and donors are yearly informed for which purpose they are applied.**

Governance

Under the umbrella of the “King Baudoin Foundation” (KBF),
the AIESEC FUND is governed by a Steering Committee

- KBF (created 1976) manages more than 350 funds which benefit from financial services as well as of legal and fiscal advice in connection with KBF-US and TGE (Transnational Giving Europe),
- TGE covers 16 countries, and allows fundraising organizations to ensure income tax deductible gifts for their foreign donors and launch tax efficient fundraising campaigns in other TGE countries.
- The Steering Committee defines the AIESEC Fund investment strategy, the allocation of its resources and ensures the funds are being used appropriately.

Committee members:

- The founders: Jean Choplin, Arnould de la Boulaye (general delegate) and Victor Loewenstein,
 - Two AAI representatives including its President,
 - Two AI representatives including its President,
 - Others: up to three outstanding personalities - former AIESEC alumni or not - to be identified and approached once the AIESEC Fund becomes operational.
- The Management Committee

Following the Steering Committee decisions, this management committee brings together the representative of KBF and the 3 founders of the AIESEC FUND to implement the decisions of the Steering Committee.

Our action

Raise some 200 K€ with the Alumni AIESEC community in the coming months to finance a few AIESEC student & alumni projects

Grants

- **This first track-record should help seek more significant funds with corporate & public actors.**
- **The AIESEC FUND Steering Committee of July 8th 2014 has approved that funds currently raised through AAI shall be – up to 100 K€ - devoted to the reinforcement of the AAI needs: website, database constitution.**
- **A team of AIESEC Alumni - mainly European to begin- must be rapidly created in order to launch this fundraising campaign with appropriate documentation and communication tools.**

Development and Influence

- **AIESEC FUND donations should reinforce the meaning and direction of actions taken by the AIESEC student and alumni communities - collective or individual projects - in order to contribute to the advancement of AIESEC in the long term.**
- **AIESEC student or alumni projects which demonstrate excellence deserve to be valued and rewarded: talented individuals will become tomorrow's leaders and collective successful projects will enhance the international reputation of AIESEC.**
